



Happy New Year!

I am pleased to announce that our 18th annual RinkSport College Prep Program will be held at Babson College in Wellesley, MA from June 19-24, 2010. Our program has served thousands of college prospects over the years, and we look forward to hosting another talented group of female student-athletes this summer. If you are planning to play ice hockey at the NCAA Division I or III level, then I highly recommend that you spend a week with us this summer!

Overview

We focus on providing you with the information you'll need to make the transition from Elite Club or High School hockey to an NCAA Varsity program. You will learn what it takes - on and off the ice to go from a college 'prospect' to a 'recruit'. You will learn about all of your options in NCAA hockey and work with some of the game's brightest and most talented coaches to help plan your strategy. Each day you'll be coached in a team setting and will participate in 2 practices, 2 off-ice sessions, and lectures. In the evenings, your team will compete in games using NCAA rules and officials. In addition to the college coaches you will be working with daily, we typically see an additional 40 or so college programs scouting at the camp each summer.

Babson College

Babson College features a beautiful campus in the town of Wellesley which is just outside of Boston, MA. The college is less than a 30 minute ride to Boston's Logan Airport (BOS), and easily accessible by car from anywhere in New England, New York, or the Mid-Atlantic states. If you are flying in for the program, we will provide transportation to and from Boston Logan Airport. There are over 30 NCAA Women's Hockey programs within a 4-hour drive from campus, making college visits easy to schedule.

We will be using Babson's on campus ice rink for practices and all games. We may also use The William Chase Arena in Natick (5 miles away) for some practices if needed. RinkSport will have full use of the Babson athletic facilities including weight room, pool, track, fields, and classrooms. Players will stay in the Babson College dorms and eat all meals at the dining hall.

Admission

RinkSport complies with NCAA guidelines and therefore we do not 'invite' players into this program. The 2010 College Prep Program is open to any female ice hockey player entering grades 10-12 (or PG'ing) in Fall 2010. Keep in mind that there are limits on the number of players we can accept at each position.

NOTE: This program may not be suitable for all players. Those who cannot handle the physical demands of a vigorous training program, or are looking for a recreational camp should consider another program.

2010 Staff

Coaches selected to work in our program are some of the most talented and accomplished in their field. Players are assigned to a team with 2 college coaches who will run their Rinksport team as if it were a college team. Two teams typically practice together each session, which allows each player to work with each coach throughout the week.

Off the ice, coaches are freely accessible and are eager to talk to players in the program about anything related to college and college hockey. Getting to know the coaches (and vice versa) is one of the most valuable aspects of our program!
